After we suddenly lost my husband and father of my fiveyear-old daughter, our worlds turned upside down. After a few weeks I decided not to attend my daughter Lauren's Kindergarten open house because I was planning on going with my husband, but he was gone. A few weeks later, I registered my daughter for Kindergarten and explained why I didn't attend the open house. The school told me about Peace by Piece. I thought this could be a great program for Lauren, but it also turned out to be a great place for me.

Lauren could be in a place where other children also wished their mommies, daddies, brothers, or sisters could come back, but knew that this wish wouldn't come true. She looks forward to the meetings on Thursdays to see new friends and is learning to cope with feelings of losing her daddy by treasuring good memories of us as a family. At times I felt very lonely in my grief, and Peace by Piece provided me a safe place where people understood what I am going through every day. It is here that I learned that there is no right or wrong way to grieve, just what feels right to me. I also learned that in order to take good care of my little girl, it is important that I take care of myself - including my emotions.

We are forever grateful to every member and volunteer of the Edmarc and Peace by Piece organization. They may not know it, but little by little they are helping my daughter and me to restore peace in our hearts. In a way they have become a second family to us.

Life threw a devastating curve ball with the loss of my husband and father to our young children. How would our family face the upcoming holidays, next month or even another day without him? I don't even remember how we connected with Peace by Piece, but what a blessing it was from day 1. My children bonded with others their age as well as to their group leaders. Because of them, they were able to express their thoughts, feelings and not have to pretend "everything was fine." This was the one place where we all felt safe, did not feel alone in grief, and could easily talk about our loved one and let our tears freely flow.

I was able to meet with other adults as well as widows which was a lifesaver. Their experiences and advice helped me navigate through some pretty discouraging and depressing times. Peace by Piece is a group led by caring people who have helped my family rebuild our lives. They walked with us on our long path through grief and were instrumental in our pressing forward toward healing and hope.

For this and the many other things they do, we are forever grateful!!

"If I did not have Peace by Piece, I would have felt more sad and lonely," said my daughter Neyla. I think that statement perfectly sums up the impact Peace by Piece has had on our family. When we first came to Peace by Piece, we felt so sad, alone and frightened about our future. However, since the very first meeting we realized that we were not alone, and that there were other young families going through the same family crisis. We were able to meet others and form friendships with people who could relate to all of the mixed feelings that comes from losing a loved one. The meetings also provided a distraction from our normal routine of living in our own space with grief. Here at the meetings, we didn't have to mask our feelings and we were given a space to have fun at times, via fellowship with food, family nights, and recognizing birthdays. Lastly, the fear of our future was lessened by the hope offered and found in the meetings. Due the flexibility to attend the meetings as long as needed, we have seen families in every phase of their grief journey, which has allowed us to see with good support, grace, and time peace can be restored.
