While music played throughout the Edmarc garden we remembered those dear to us through our annual slide show of pictures followed by the lighting of candles in remembrance of each child. These candles are a representation of their everlasting light that continues to shine in each of us whom these children's lives have touched. First of all, a video conference with a group of jolly, bearded Santas and one sweet Mrs. Claus is an amazing way to spend an afternoon. As we began talking about what would be possible and how we could safely achieve our goals, they made one thing abundantly clear: Edmarc couldn't stop Santa's sleigh from arriving. We knew we could not have all the bells and whistles this year; however, something simple and meaningful might just be what families needed. So we focused on the essentials. plexiglass divider so he and kids could be in the same picture while still being safe. (Some smaller children who would normally be terrified of the bearded man actually preferred this.) Because of his innovations, numerous Edmarc families were able to come out on a Saturday afternoon and have their pictures taken by Sarah Vanderford Photography and Captivated Productions, allowing them to create special memories to treasure forever.

We missed our fire and police personnel driving through the streets with Santa and gifts in tow. We missed our mass of volunteers wrapping gifts at Edmarc while listening to holiday music. We missed throwing a festive party that would allow families and staff to come together to celebrate the season.
